The impact of changes in exchange rate pertaining to unhedged foreign currency assets and liabilities as on 31-12-2008 have not been considered. In case such items are revalued at the closing exchange rate on 31-12-2008, the net result would have been lower by Rs. 2.26 crore. The Company has entered into Forward Contracts to hedge the future payables related to project imports and future receivables (exports). The mark to market notional loss on such contracts outstanding as on 31-12-2008 aggregating to Rs. 32.67 crore is recognised in the Hedging Reserve

status quo. The Auditors in the Limited Review Report for the nine months ended 31-12-2008 have observed that the reduction of exchange gain in the cost of fixed assets in the previous years has resulted in understatement of depreciation by Rs. 0.63 crore.

Exchange loss/gain during MDP project construction period is adjusted against the cost of fixed assets. Accounting of exchange gain of Rs.18,74 crore pertaining to MDP project construction period in the previous years was qualified by the Auditors in the Accounts for the year ended 31-3-2008 stating that the profit has been understated to the extent of exchange gain adjusted in the fixed assets. The Company has referred the matter to the Expert Advisory Committee of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India for opinion. Pending receipt of opinion, the Company maintains the

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
