PLANTATION POLICY

There is no evidence of any practices indicative of forced or compulsory labour in TNPL including but not limited to, the following:

- **Physical and sexual violence**
- **Bonded labour**
- **Withholding of wages /including payment of employment fees and or payment of deposit to commence employment**
- **Restriction of mobility/movement**
- **Retention of passport and identity documents**
- **Threats of denunciation to the authorities.**
